

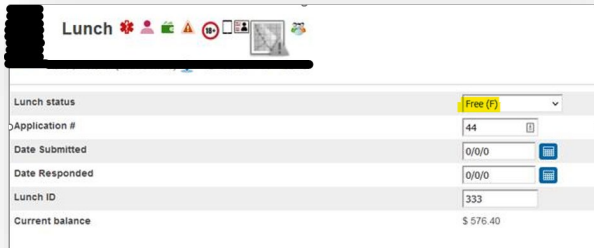
Direct Certification and National School Lunch Program (NS Lunch)

Any school lunch program other than 'full pay' falls under the NS Lunch Program.

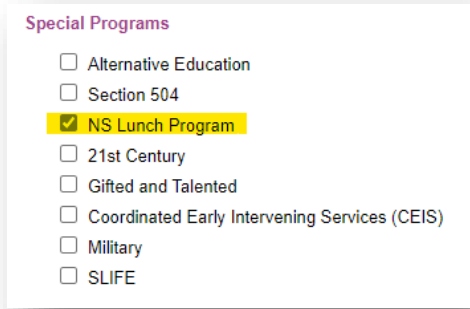
DPI and DHS perform a matching process to **Directly Certify** a student to receive free lunch. Once the student is linked to a school, the student will be marked as **Direct Cert** in STARS and PowerSchool. All students marked as Direct Cert also need to be identified as NS Lunch.

Students identified as homeless also need to be identified as NS Lunch.

Identify students in PowerSchool

Select a student Under 'Administration', select Lunch Select a lunch status from the pull-down menu Submit Note: Every student entered in PowerSchool must have a lunch status Note: Lunch status does not roll over from previous years	

Identify Students in STARS

Narrative	Screenshot
Students who participate in anything other than 'full pay' will be marked as NS Lunch Program Note: This indicator should originate in PowerSchool and flow to STARS Note: It can be marked directly in STARS, but a 'blank' (meaning student is not identified as other than full pay) will overwrite the indicator on the nightly process	

Students who are Directly Certified and linked to a school will automatically have the Direct Cert indicator checked

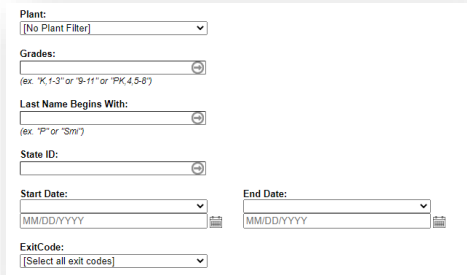
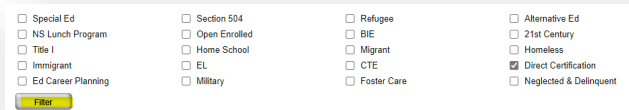
They must also be identified as participating in the NS Lunch Program in PowerSchool and STARS
