Fargo Serious Injury Motorcycle Crash

What: Injury Crash

Where: 32nd Avenue South in Fargo, westbound near I29 exit

When: April 25, 2025; 2:42 pm CT

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear/Sunny

Crash Involvement: Motorcycle

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Fargo Police Department, FM Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2014 Harley Davidson

Driver No. 1: Male, 67 years old, Fargo, ND, serious injuries

Restraints: Helmet

Charges: Under investigation

NARRATIVE: On April 25, 2025, at 2:42pm, a motorcycle was traveling westbound on 32nd Avenue South in Fargo. The driver failed to negotiate the curve, left the roadway, and entered the west gravel ditch ultimately crashing. The driver sustained serious injuries and was transported via ambulance to a local hospital.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
