Barnes County Injury cattle hauler crash

What: One vehicle injury crash

Where: I-94 milepost 276 (16 miles west of Valley City, ND)

When: January 17, 2025 at 4:01 AM

Road Conditions: Asphalt, Dry

Weather Conditions: Dark-Not lighted

Crash Involvement: Peterbilt truck left the roadway and overturned.

Agencies Involved: Barnes County Sheriff, Barnes County Ambulance, Barnes County Ambulance, Valley City Fire and Rescue, Stockman's Association, and the ND Highway Patrol.

Vehicle No. 1: 2007 Peterbilt Truck

Driver No. 1: Joshua Borden, 55, of Menomonie, WI- injured

Restraints: Belted

Charges: Care-Required

NARRATIVE: The Peterbilt truck was eastbound on I-94 when the truck was driven off the road into the south ditch. The truck overturned onto the passenger side facing east.

The driver, Joshua, was treated on scene by the Barnes County Ambulance and not transported. Joshua sustained minor injuries in the crash.

The semi was loaded with 77 head of cattle. Initial report of six dead calves with further evaluations to be completed. First responders set up traffic control in the eastbound lanes. Lanes were reduced to one lane for six hours while crews worked to trailer the remaining cattle and remove the semi.

The Stockman's Association is still searching for one missing calf. The public is asked to call Barnes County dispatch or the Stockman's Association if a black 700 lb. calf is located. Barnes County Dispatch: (701) 845-8181, Stockman's Association: (701) 595-6269.
